

Robex Road Line Paint

Preparation

The surface to be painted must be dry and free from oil, dust, road salts and other contaminants before application.

Preparation by captive blast is recommended for very smooth block pavers

Coating Galvanized Iron and Zinc/Aluminium and its Alloys: Special preparation/priming is required for these surfaces depending on the age and condition. Please refer to our technical department before applying any Robex coating to this type of surface.

Application

Apply with a solvent friendly, medium roller, brush or by airless spray.

Recommended tip sizes 17-19

Tip angles as an indication

20° 50 mm line

30° 75 mm line

40° 100 mm lines

Mix thoroughly prior to use and do not apply when the air or surface temperature is less than 5°c.

Application should also be avoided if rain is imminent or there is mist, fog or high humidity (minimum 3° above dew point and less than 80%)

Drying Time

Touch @ 20°c: 12 minutes at 700 microns (will vary with temperature)

Coverage

Approximately 200 metres of a 50 mm line per 6kgs.depending on the porosity of the surface. One coat normally sufficient.

Cleaning

To clean brushes, equipment, contaminants, etc., we recommend the use of Robex Cleaning Solvent RX117.

Shelf Life

12 months under good storage conditions

Can be stores for a period of 12 months in its original packaging if not opened. Temperature range 50°c to 35°c.
